



GETTING STARTED WITH DRONESENSE:

Managing Your Program's Data

Logging in to DroneSense

1. Open your browser to <https://web.dronesense.com>.
2. Log in using your organization ID, email and password, and MFA code if your organization uses multi-factor authentication.

Dashboard

The Dashboard page provides a snapshot of your program.

The summary at the top shows the current total of drones, pilots, flights, and incidents. You can click each to view in more detail.

The calendar shows your flights, missions, and incidents. Use the filters to narrow these by category.

Side Menu

The side menu provides access to the different types of data in your org. Click the menu button to show or hide the names of each page.

User Menu

The User menu at the top of the page provides access to your user profile.

You can also select **Help** to access the DroneSense support site, which contains detailed documentation, FAQ and troubleshooting information, and ability to submit and manage support tickets.

Quick Add

The **Quick Add** button to the left of the User menu makes it easy to manually add records for Flights & Missions and Hardware, file NOTAMs, log Incidents, and create Locations.
